
Comments: The CVCC Nursing Program is in compliance with Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN) & the North Carolina Board of Nursing (NCBON), providing recognized educational preparation to sit for the NCLEX-RN, a national exam for Registered Nurse Licensure. The North Carolina Board of Nursing, grants

licensure and participates in the Interstate Commission of Nurse Licensure (ICNL) allowing for Nurses licensed in the state of North Carolina the privilege to work in other Nursing Licensure Compact (NLC) States (as designated in this report). Regulations require a change of residency process be completed within 60 days of relocation to comply with the ICNL & State Board's of Nursing. Other non-compact states may have pathways to licensure based on student's academic preparation and possession of an unencumbered NC Registered Nurse License, however the nurse may not work in those states until the Board of Nursing grants licensure by endorsement or other means.


